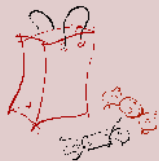

Setting the stage for braces



Did you know that in special cases, we recommend starting braces earlier, sometimes even when you still have baby teeth? Situations in which there is not

enough room in the mouth for all the teeth to erupt. Some patients with special conditions will benefit from "two-phase treatment" which consists of two periods of treatment, the first is before the permanent teeth erupt and the second takes place later, when the permanent teeth have come in. Orthodontic work is best performed during stages of rapid growth. Phase One

treatment serves to prevent or intercept a problem that could cause trouble in your future development. It can improve self-esteem and provide a well aligned, healthy jaw and mouth, into which the permanent teeth can erupt. Remember that every patient is unique and every treatment plan is unique. We carefully examine x-rays, photo's and records to determine your needs.
